Speech Language Pathologist

GPA: A GPA in the “A” range which ranges from 80-100; A- (80-84); A (85-89); A+ (90-100)

GPA: It is calculated on the last 20 half credits like PT and OT

Pre-requisites are required

You must have relevant health-related experience, and a minimum of 14 clinical hours

And your references must be both academic & clinical

In the Personal Statement: schools are looking for SLP experiences, and attributes that you can bring to profession (Western & Toronto)

In Ontario, there are 2 universities that have the SLP program: University of Toronto and Western Ontario

Audiology

GPA: needs to be in the 80's

GPA: is also calculated on the last 20 half credits

Pre-requisites: are required

Relevant health-related experience is also required with the same minimum 14 hours as SLP

Your references are required to be both academic & clinical

And in the Personal Statement: Western is looking for audiology experiences, and attributes that you can bring to profession (Western)

You Apply through ORPAS – but there is only one school in Ontario: Western
